



The Prelims-cum-Mains (PCM) Course is built on insights gained from 11+ years of mentoring UPSC aspirants. It addresses the most common challenges faced by beginners through a structured, student-centric approach.





Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is the course fee?

The total course fee is ₹90,000 (inclusive of GST). The course includes all classes covering General Studies, CSAT, and Current Affairs, along with printed study materials and personal mentorship. For detailed information, please refer to the Course Deliverables Sheet.

2. Are instalment options available?

Yes, interest-free instalment options are available. For further details, please speak with our academic counsellor.

3. Are online class recordings provided for offline batches?

Yes. All our offline batches include online live streaming as well as access to recorded classes. Recorded classes are available for 30 days. Students who wish to repeat the course can avail one year of additional online access after course completion.

4. In which language are the classes conducted?

Classes are conducted using a combination of English and Malayalam.

5. How do students select an optional subject? Which optional subjects are available at Fortune IAS?

Students are encouraged to make an informed choice after attending orientation sessions and demo classes of various optional subjects. The optional subjects currently offered are:

- Anthropology
- Geography
- Malayalam Literature
- Public Administration
- Political Science & International Relations
- Sociology

6. Is it mandatory to take the optional subject course along with the Prelims-cum-Mains (PCM) course, or can it be taken independently?

The optional subject course is a separate program with separate fees and can be taken independently of the PCM course. However, since the optional subject plays a crucial role in the Mains stage, most students prefer to complete it alongside the PCM course.

7. How many books are provided as part of the printed study material?

A total of 10 books (including CSAT) are provided as part of the Prelims study kit, and 6 books are provided as part of the Mains study kit. In addition, students receive a monthly hard copy of Precise, the Current Affairs magazine, for 12 months.

8. Is mentorship provided during the course?

Yes. One-on-one personal mentorship is provided under our DISHA Program, along with support during the Prelims Test Series and Mains Test Series.

9. Is any scholarship available?

Yes. Ten students have successfully cleared UPSC through our scholarship program. The 2026 Scholarship Test will be conducted on June 6.

10. Is hostel facility provided?

No, Fortune IAS does not directly operate hostels. However, there is a wide network of hostels near the academy, and a curated list of recommended hostels is available at the academy front office upon request.

11. Is a reading room facility available?

Yes. A reading room with 700 individual cubicles is available exclusively for PCM batch students.
